

Privacy Policy of the website [edsd.com](https://www.edsd.com)

1. General Provisions

This policy on the processing of personal data is prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Law "On Personal Data" (hereinafter referred to as the "Personal Data Law") and defines the procedure for processing personal data and measures to ensure the security of personal data on the website owned by Edison LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Company").

By providing your personal data, you consent to their processing in accordance with this policy.

2. Terms

- 2.1. Personal Data (PD) — any information relating to a directly or indirectly identified or identifiable individual (data subject).
- 2.2. Processing of Personal Data (Processing) — any action/operation or a set of actions/operations performed with personal data, with or without the use of automation means.
- 2.3. Operator — a state body, municipal body, legal entity or individual, independently or jointly with other persons, organizing and/or carrying out the processing of personal data, as well as determining the purposes of personal data processing, the composition of personal data to be processed, actions (operations) performed with personal data.
- 2.4. Company — Edison Limited Liability Company — the operator of personal data.
- 2.5. Website — the Company's information resource on the "Internet", accessible via the domain name "[edsd.com](https://www.edsd.com)".
- 2.6. Confidentiality of personal data — a mandatory requirement for a person who has gained access to personal data not to disclose or distribute personal data to third parties without the consent of the data subject, unless otherwise provided by law.

3. Purposes, Categories, Legal Grounds, and Terms of Personal Data Processing

- 3.1. The Company, as the Operator, processes personal data for the following purposes.

- 3.2. When a Visitor submits an inquiry, the Company processes the data specified in such inquiry for the purpose of responding to it.

- 3.3. The Company does not process biometric data, nor information concerning race, nationality, political views, religious or philosophical beliefs.
- 3.4. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the consent to the processing of personal data.

4. Use of Cookies

- 4.1. Cookies are small files that are created and stored by the browser when a user visits the Company's Website. Cookies allow tracking the quality of the Website's performance and its usage characteristics, as well as optimizing marketing activities on the Internet. Cookies are stored on the user's device for a period that may depend on the corresponding type of cookies. Session cookies are stored only for the duration of the visit to the Website. Persistent cookies may be stored on the user's device after finishing the session on the Website and are used by the Website upon subsequent visits, but not longer than the period necessary to achieve their purpose, after which they will be automatically deleted from the user's device.
- 4.2. Visiting and using the Website by default involves the generation and storage of cookies. However, the user can delete cookies from the device at any time through the settings of the browser used. The user can also refuse to accept cookies, but the full functionality of the Website is not guaranteed in this case.

5. Basic Rules and Principles of Personal Data Processing

- 5.1. The Company processes personal data, namely: collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, clarification (updating, modification), retrieval, use, transfer (distribution, provision, access), blocking, deletion, and destruction of personal data only if there are grounds and within the timeframes provided for by the current legislation.
- 5.2. The processing of personal data by the Company is carried out both with and without the use of automation means, including mixed processing.
- 5.3. When processing personal data, the Company observes the rights of personal data subjects and fulfills the obligations of the Operator stipulated by the legislation on personal data.
- 5.4. The Company processes personal data based on the following principles.
 - 5.4.1. The processing of personal data is carried out on a lawful and fair basis.
 - 5.4.2. The processing of personal data is limited to the achievement of specific, predetermined, and lawful purposes.
 - 5.4.3. The processing of personal data that is incompatible with the purposes of their collection is not permitted.
 - 5.4.4. Only personal data that meets the purposes of their processing are subject to processing.
 - 5.4.5. The content and scope of the processed personal data correspond to the stated purposes of processing. Redundancy of the processed personal data in relation to the stated purposes of their processing is not permitted.
 - 5.4.6. Storage of personal data is carried out in a form that allows identification of the data subject, for no longer than required by the purposes of personal data processing, unless the storage period for personal data is established by law, consent to processing, or an agreement to which the data subject is a party, beneficiary, or guarantor.
 - 5.4.7. Processed personal data is destroyed upon achieving the processing purposes or in case of the loss of necessity to achieve these purposes, unless otherwise provided by law.
 - 5.4.8. The processing of personal data is not used for the purpose of causing property and/or moral harm to data subjects, hindering the exercise of their rights and freedoms.

6. Measures to Ensure the Security of Personal Data

The Company takes necessary legal, organizational, and technical measures to protect the received personal data from unlawful or accidental access, destruction, modification, blocking, copying, disclosure, distribution of personal data, and other unlawful actions regarding personal data, and observes the principles and rules of personal data processing provided for by the Personal Data Law and other regulatory acts.

7. Rights of Personal Data Subjects and Contacts for Personal Data Processing Inquiries

7.1. When their personal data is processed, subjects have the right to:

- 7.1.1. request information related to the processing of their personal data;
- 7.1.2. demand the clarification, destruction, or blocking of their personal data if the data is incomplete, outdated, inaccurate, unlawfully obtained, or is not necessary for the stated processing purpose;
- 7.1.3. object to the processing of their personal data;
- 7.1.4. withdraw the consent to the processing of personal data provided to the Company;
- 7.1.5. demand the termination of the processing of their personal data.

8. Final Provisions

- 8.1. The Policy applies to all Personal Data that the Company receives from the personal data subject.
- 8.2. The Company is not responsible for the actions of third parties who gained access to the Personal Data of the personal data subject through his/her fault.
- 8.3. The Company has the right to make changes to the Policy. The new version of the Policy comes into force from the moment of its publication at: <https://www.edsd.com/files/pdf/Privacy-Policy-of-the-website.pdf>.
- 8.4. This Policy applies to personal data received both before and after the enactment of this Policy.
- 8.5. If the User continues to use the Website after the new version of the Policy comes into force, this will mean that they have agreed to the terms of the new version of the Policy.
